
# ADP Canada National Employment Report: Employment in Canada Increased by 30,200 Jobs in April 2018

TORONTO, May 17, 2018 /CNW/ -- Employment in Canada increased by 30,200 jobs from March to April according to the April *ADP*<sup>®</sup> *Canada National Employment Report*. Broadly distributed to the public each month, free of charge, the *ADP Canada National Employment Report* is produced by the ADP Research Institute<sup>®</sup>. The report, which is derived from actual ADP payroll data, measures the change in total nonfarm payroll employment each month on a seasonally-adjusted basis.

"Canada experienced strong job growth across most industries in the month of April," said Ahu Yildirmaz, vice president and co-head of the ADP Research Institute. "Top performers were professional and business services, trade, and manufacturing but overall we saw solid gains across all industries except for leisure and hospitality."


